## GRAMMAR WORKBOOK



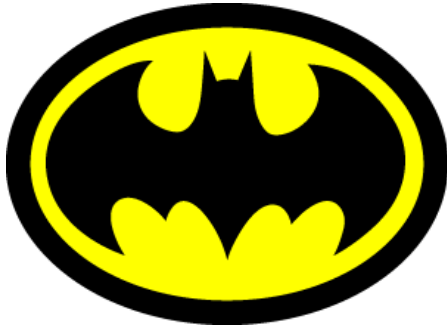
### Purpose

Each of you will create a grammar exercise workbook to serve as a review guide and as a teaching strategy. You will create workbook pages for 20-25 grammar or mechanics entries.

### Format

Each worksheet will have four labeled parts:

- *Rule*: Identify and explain the grammar rule or principle
- *Example*: Write two or three clear, purposeful examples to illustrate the rule or principle.
- *Exercise*: Create an exercise using ten sentences that loosely connected to form a unified thought.
- *Answer Key*: Copy the exercise and insert the typed answers into each sentence.



### Guidelines

To help keep this assignment uniform, incorporate the following guidelines.

- Utilize characters, settings, or themes from a particular theme, book, or film for all examples and exercises.
- Keep all explanations, examples, and exercises simple—perhaps for a 7<sup>th</sup> grade class.
- Use a bold title to identify the subject of the worksheet such as **Batman's Commas**.
- Label each section of the worksheet with italics: *Rule*, *Example*, and *Exercise*.
- Use Times New Roman 12 point font.
- Keep the worksheet on a separate page.



### Postings

- Students will post individual workbook sheets on I-Learn Discussion Board under the appropriate week.
- Students will respond to two other postings checking for clarity and accuracy.
- Students will bind final grammar workbook for submission.
